

DRESS CODE

As part of our mission to prepare students for careers in the airline and travel industry, International Air & Hospitality Academy requires students to dress in a way that will create a professional self image. Apparel worn to school should be neat, clean, and fit to a standard of good taste and modesty.

Casual attire will be accepted daily unless otherwise directed. Changes to casual attire can occur during formal events like graduations, interviews, and other activities as defined by the education and career services departments. If you own school uniforms and choose to continue wearing them, please do.

Items NOT Considered Casual Attire

- Holey or torn garments (even if purchased that way)
- Yoga Pants
- Sweatpants
- Shorts
- Pajamas
- Low cut tops
- NO dresses or skirts allowed
- Hats, bandanas, sweatshirt hoods, or sunglasses
- Flip flops, sandals or slippers
- Shirts or tops with obscene or offensive language or pictures
- Bare or exposed midriffs
- Tank tops or halters
- Sheer or see-through fabrics
- Outerwear must be removed once in the building
- Visible tattoos
- Piercings of nose, tongue, etc.
- School badges must be worn at all times without exceptions.
